

DNA REQUIREMENTS
(In effect 07/20/07)

All horses applying for registration with AGMH/ASMH must have parentage proven through DNA submitted to the U. of KY through a sharing registry (AGMH/ASMH, RMHA, or MPHA). All available DNA reports (regardless of origin) for the applicant horse should be submitted to AGMH at the time of application for registration.

If a horse has been DNA'd solely through a non-sharing registry, such as KMSHA, the horse must submit a new DNA sample for proof of parentage through a sharing registry (AGMH/ASMH, RMHA, or MPHA). In the case of incomplete proof of parentage through existing DNA, additional DNA samples may be required of the applicant horse's parents before AGMH/ASMH registration can be completed.

GELDINGS:

Geldings must provide DNA as outlined above in the same fashion as mares and stallions. This is for proof of IDENTITY and is for owners', breeders', and buyers' protection.
